

# Check-out Dives

**Congratulations!** You've started your way to becoming a certified Scuba Diver, and your Adventures in the underwater world are just beginning.

Now is the time to be thinking about your next steps, completing your open water check out dives. These are 4 dives which take place over 2 days.

We have lots of options for you to choose from, (please see our attached schedule), you may wish to complete the 4 required dives locally, or kick it up a notch and go away on a weekend certification trip, or even a tropical holiday.

Our local options include midweek evenings, or weekends, simply select the best option for you and reserve ahead.

Please note there is a maximum of 8 students per check out session, so please reserve ahead of time, (no later than your 4<sup>th</sup> module) to avoid disappointment.

**Schedule changes:** We understand that sometimes a change in schedule may be necessary, and 24 hours notice would be appreciated, if you are unable to attend a scheduled dive. Less than 24 hours notice or missing a class will lead to a \$20 instructor fee charged to your account.
